Open-Up by lllustrative Mathematics: Students are provided with workbooks for each unit. It is a very hands-on approach to learning mathematics that promotes conceptual understanding and fosters collaboration. A Family Letter from WCPSS can be accessed via the QR code.


Homework: Every problem on a homework assignment should show some attempt or thought process. A question mark shows no thought process. Homework will be given on a daily basis and is due the next day. Homework is extremely important to practice what was taught in class.

Absences and Make Up Work: Students who are absent from my class are responsible for collecting any missing work and notes from the days of their absence(s). If an absence occurs, it is very important and expected that a student uses all resources, calls a class member, or checks my website.

Test Corrections: Test corrections are available on unit tests if the student scores below $70 \%$. The student must attend a mandatory Leopard Time review session. Before entering they must show proof of a complete study guide. At the end of the review session they will receive a test correction template. Students can earn $50 \%$ back of what they lost on their original test with a $70 \%$ being the highest score they can receive. These will be due on a posted date within the classroom.
