<u>Homework</u>

Absences and Make Up Work: Students who are absent from my class are responsible for collecting any missing work and notes from the days of their absence(s). If an absence occurs, it is very important and expected that a student uses all resources, calls a class member, or checks my website.

Late Work Policy

MPMS late work policy is a 0.5 point deduction on the assignment's point value each day it is late. This deduction is taken after the assignment has been graded. This can add up so be sure to stay organized!

<u>Test Corrections</u>: Test corrections are available on unit tests if the student scores below 70%. The student must attend a mandatory Leopard Time review session. Before entering they must show proof of a complete study guide. At the end of the review session they will receive a test correction template. Students can earn 50% back of what they lost on their original test with the highest score being a 70%. These will be due on a posted date within the classroom.
